Dear all

As we near the end of 2009, the CIP has been following Hampshire's work on developing Local Children's Partnerships.

Local Children's Partnerships are envisaged as the delivery arm of the Hampshire Children's Trust in implementing action to improve outcomes identified within the Children and Young People's Plan.

- Ensure educational inclusion
- Strengthen and develop local networks
- Develop a local delivery plan, based upon a detailed understanding of needs and outcomes
- Have a direct responsibility for delivery locally of defined outcomes, e.g. teenage pregnancy, reducing child poverty and improving school attendance
- Influence improvement for all outcomes for all children
- Co-ordinate early intervention and prevention activities

These arrangements allow for schools and colleges to form collaborative partnerships together, and with others, to undertake agreed activities: Members of the partnership retain accountability to their existing governance and management arrangements. In this way the partnership comes together to agree common priorities and action of benefit to local children and young people with the support of their management and governance arrangements.

New Diploma Roadshow for teens coming to Havant

A Roadshow focusing on the new Diploma Qualification aimed at teenagers will take place on **Wednesday 13th January** at Horndean Technology College, from 2.00pm to 6.30pm, with the first 3 hours reserved for schools.

Aimed at young people aged between 13 and 19, the Roadshow will show the range of Diploma courses available in Havant and enable youngsters to meet the tutors, enjoy interactive demonstrations and watch live performances by local students.

The Higher Diploma is equivalent to seven GCSEs at grades A* to C. From September 2010, Havant 14-19 Consortium will deliver Higher level Diplomas covering Hospitality, Information Technology, Creative and Media, Engineering, Business, Administration and Finance, Travel and Tourism, Sport and Active Leisure, Society, Health and Development plus Hair and Beauty Studies. From September 2011, Havant 14-19 Consortium will also offer Construction and the Built Environment.

The Diploma lines above will be delivered on a collaborative basis by the consortium members: Oaklands Catholic School and 6th Form College, Horndean Technology College, South Downs College, Prospect School, Warblington School, Park Community School, The Hayling College, Staunton Community Sports College, Havant College, Purbrook Park School, Crookhorn College of Technology, Cowplain Community College and PETA.

CIP Co-ordinator updates with a review of 2009 projects:

Cackle and Pop party/ACE—Next 'Cackle and Pop' free discos for Primary age children will be on 30.11.09 with an event for 210 children at Park Community school (5.30 – 7.30pm). This year's events are being funded by The Safer Havant Partnership, but other community partners are also participating and supporting the event. Guinness-Hermitage have also donated additional funding for this special Christmas themed event.

The 'ACE' group are also planning a celebration event on 29.1.2010 at Park Community, where the achievements of local young people will be celebrated alongside a showcase for the groups work during 2009. If you are interested in receiving an invitation to this event please contact the CIP office.

Park Youth 'drop-in' - October 09—During the recent school holidays, Park Community School have been running a free 'drop-in' session. This has been well attended by young people from 8 – 14 yrs old. To support this new service the CIP funded a play worker to be available to supervise the young people for some sessions. Funding is also provided for February 2010.

LP Community Association Christmas Grotto—local schools will be attending the opening of the Christmas Grotto on 4.12.09 at Park parade. Each school will be singing a Christmas song to greet Father Christmas and the Mayor of Havant, who will be officially opening the Grotto for this year.
